have many children in our neighborhood so here is a quick guide to help keep them safe.

- Never pass a bus if it is stopped to load or unload children.

- If the yellow or red lights are flashing, traffic must stop.

- The area 10 feet around a school bus is the most dangerous for children, stop far back enough to safely allow children to enter and exit the bus.

- Be alert, children are often unpredictable and tend to ignore hazards.

- Always use extreme caution near school bus stops and in school zones.

- Leave your house early so you are not rushing.

Happy Halloween


Each year, the city of Fishers posts official trick or treat
